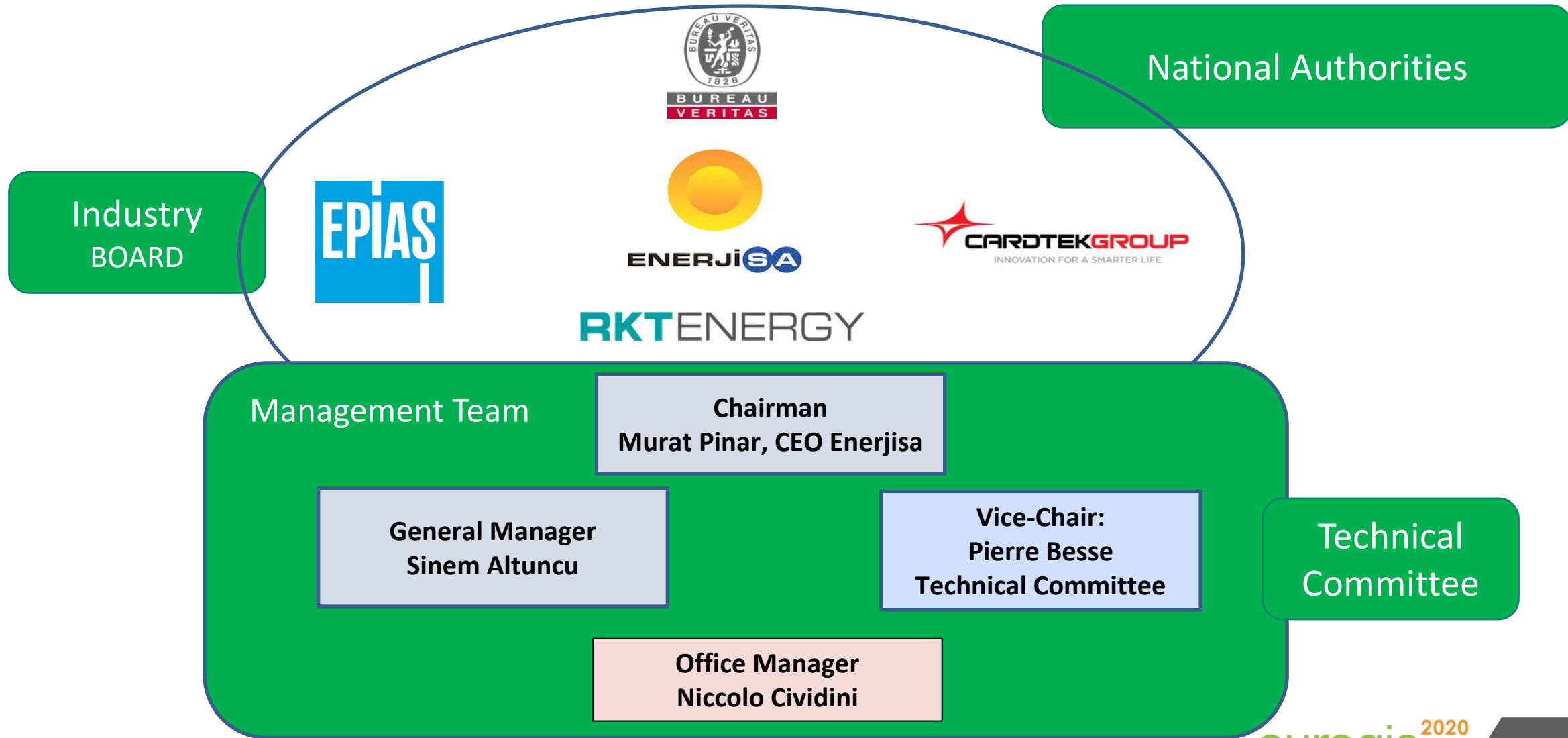

through extensive/continuous feedback and access to the EUROGIA network

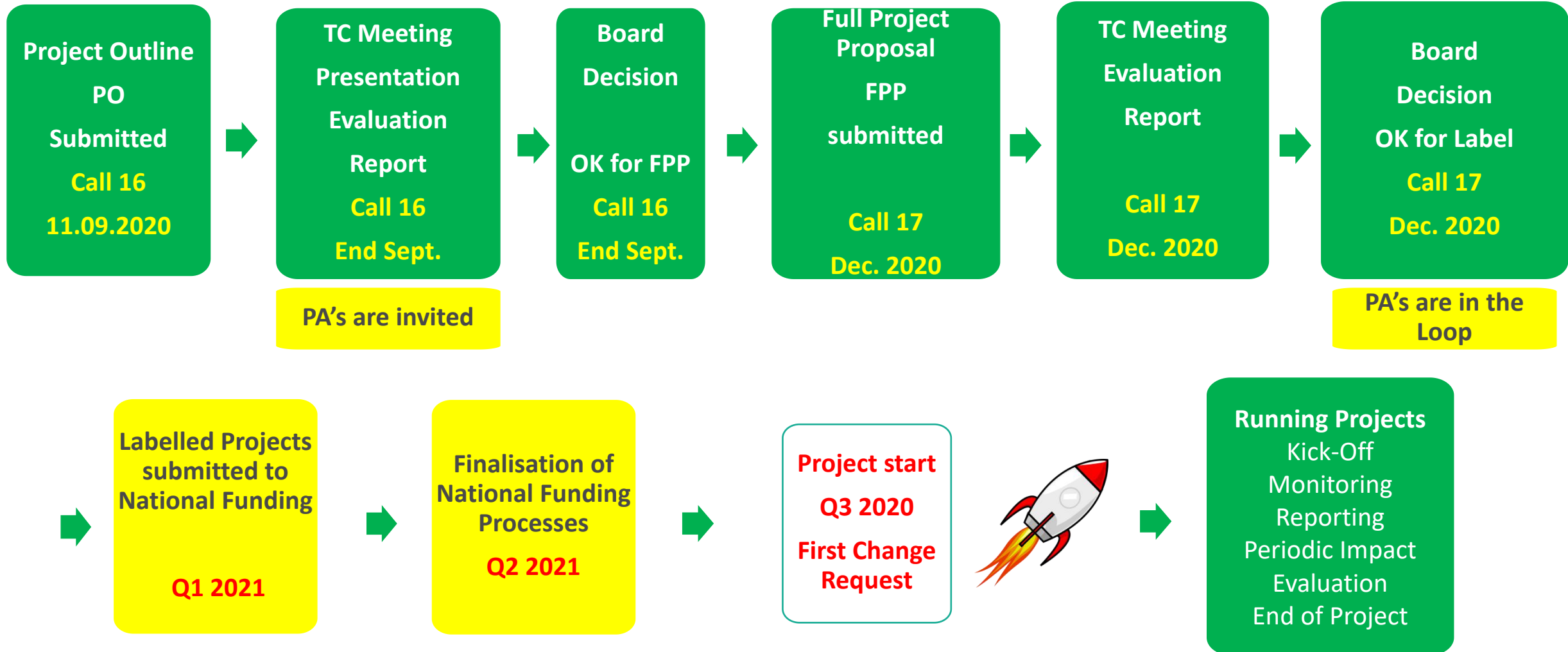
Funding *success about 80%* for labelled projects

No competition between similar projects

quality of your own project is what counts

But parallel applications in each country in addition to global Eurogia2020 application; and synchronisation of funding from each country not always achieved.

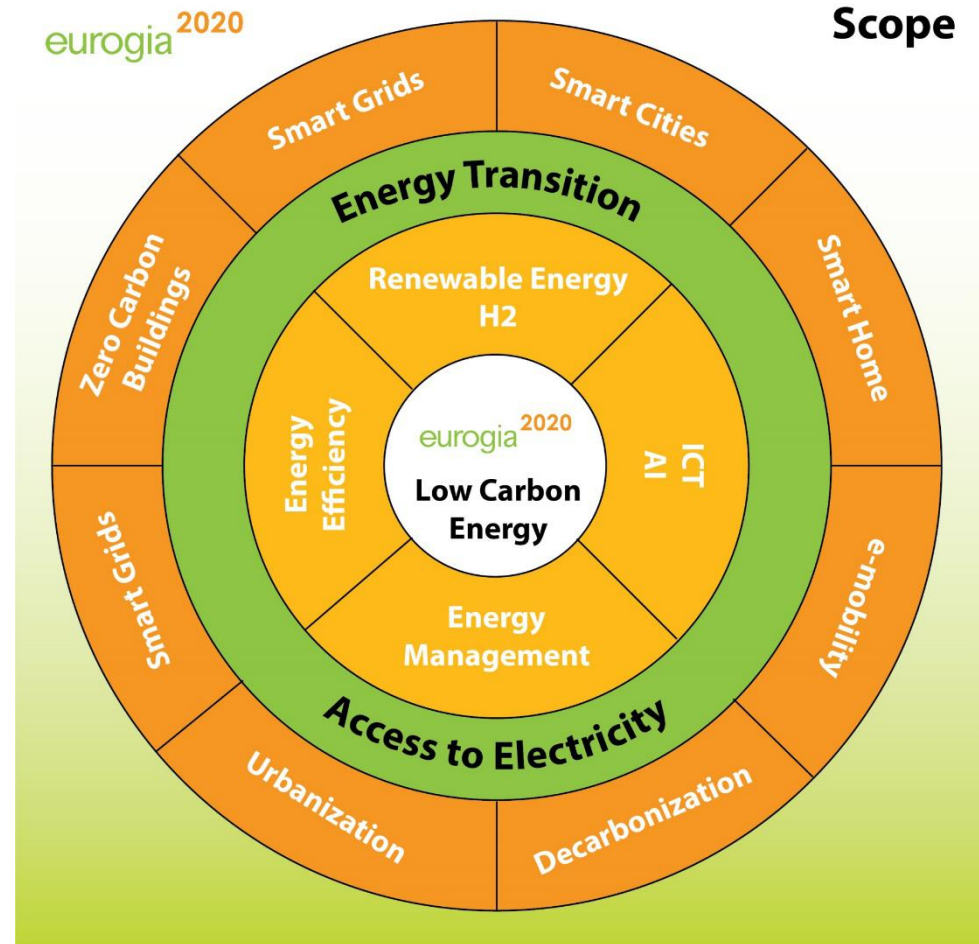

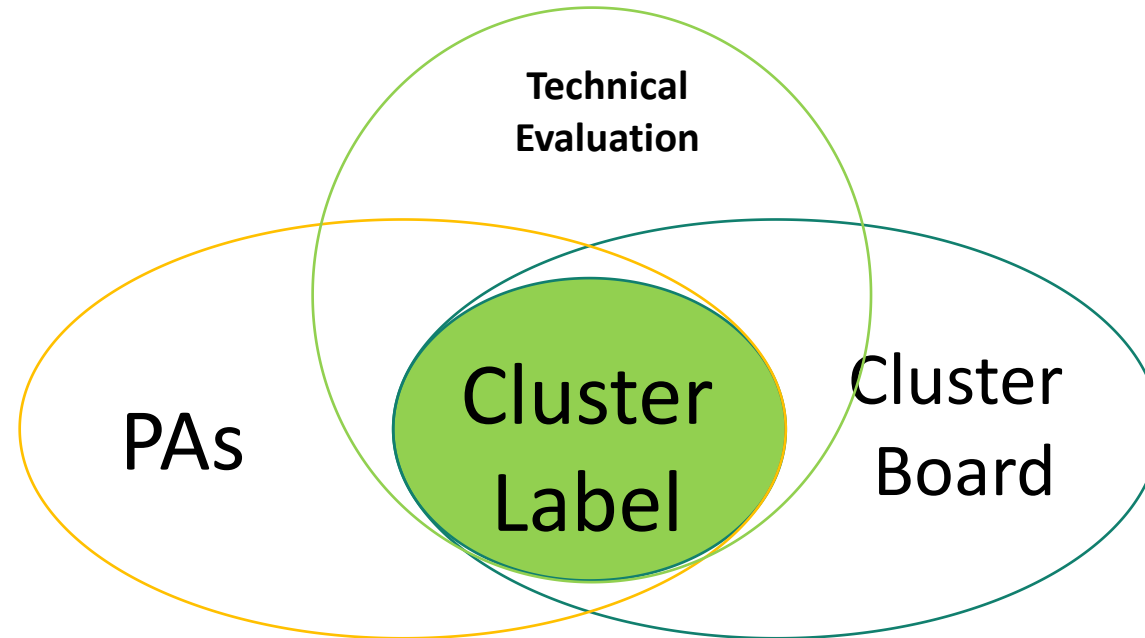

Starting and running a EUROGIA project

- In EUREKA projects the funding is granted by ministries of the participating countries.
- Projects usually start when mandatory partners have green light for funding.
- The project fees are 1,5% of the funded budget.
